

**ETL Listing Mark -Direct Imprint information** 

If you wish to direct imprint the ETL Listing Mark to the product the below described 4 items shall be included. The ETL listing mark should be visible after the product is installed.

An e-mail of the imprint as it will appear on the product must be submitted to Intertek for approval prior to use. <a href="mailto:etlriceu@intertek.com">etlriceu@intertek.com</a>

The ETL marks are available in JPG and EPS format on request from our office.

## The ETL Listing Mark:

The ETL Listing Mark consists of the following four items:

- 1. The ETL mark with "US" and/or "C" as identifiers. The letter "C" adjacent and to the lower left side of the ETL Mark indicates that the product complies with a Canadian standard. The letters "US" adjacent and to the lower right side of the ETL Mark indicates that the product complies with a US standard.
- 2. The word, "Listed" or "ETL Classified" or "Recognized Component" (whichever is appropriate). The word, "Listed" is to be incorporated into the ETL Mark. If upon reduction, the word "Listed" is not legible as part of the mark, it shall also appear separately. The word "ETL Classified" or "Recognized Component" should be above the ETL mark.
- 3. The Control Number issued by Intertek. This five to eleven-digit number is unique to the manufacturing site for each applicant. The control number should be under the ETL mark.
  - If you have not received the control number the sample of the imprint should show the control number as xxxxxx.
  - The control number will be issued <u>after signed Certification Agreements</u> have been received by the Follow-up Services office, approval of the imprint of your proposed ETL Listing Mark and satisfactory completion of the Listing Report.
- 4. A standard description, which refers to the national standard used for certification shall be used. Example:

**For US standards**, the words, "Conforms to" shall appear with the standard number along with the word, "Standard" or "Std."

Example: "Conforms to UL Std. XX." Or "Conforms to ANSI/UL Std. XX."

**For Canadian standards**, the words "Certified to" or "Cert. to" shall appear with the standard number along with the word, "Standard" or "Std."

Example: "Cert. to CSA Std. CXX No. XX." Or "Cert. to CAN/CSA Std. CXX No. XX."

If the manufacturer wishes, they may use the standard title, example "Telephone Equipment."





## **ETL Listing Mark -Direct Imprint information**

Place for the word (if required): Recognized Component ETL Classified



Example of the standard reference:

Conforms to UL Std. XX. Cert. to CSA Std. CXX No. XX

Place for control number: XXXXXX
